



Problem-solving methodologies:

The School of Pharmacy uses Problem-Based Learning (PBL) as a key academic strategy to develop critical thinking, clinical reasoning, and problem-solving skills among students. PBL sessions involve structured activities where students face real-world healthcare and pharmaceutical challenges, allowing them to apply their knowledge across disciplines to find practical solutions. Students work in small groups to analyze information, identify issues, research interventions, and propose solutions, strengthening subject comprehension, decision-making, teamwork, and communication skills. The School of Pharmacy incorporates practical tools and immersive learning environments, such as the Pharma Brigade, a student-led platform that allows learners to take charge of real-time industry or community health projects. This initiative exposes students to leadership roles and interdisciplinary collaboration while working on pharmaceutical innovation or public health outreach programs. Hands-on training on sophisticated instruments like High-Performance Liquid Chromatography (HPLC) further enriches the problem-solving experience, allowing students to better understand the application of scientific principles in quality control, drug analysis, and research development.

1. Igniting Young Minds: Startup, Entrepreneur, and Incubation Ideas Program

Objective:

Key programs like Startup India, Stand-Up India, and state-specific incentives for startups were discussed, highlighting the financial and mentorship support available for budding entrepreneurs.

3. Incubation Ideas Program:

A key feature of the event was the introduction of the "Incubation Ideas Program," where students were encouraged to present their innovative startup ideas. They were guided on how incubation centres like GUSEC can assist with resources, mentoring, office space, and technical support to transform their ideas into sustainable businesses. Selected ideas were discussed for potential incubation support.

4. Seed Money:

An important part of the session discussed seed funding – explaining how initial funding works, its importance for early-stage startups, and the ways to apply for seed money from government and private sources. Real examples of students who secured funding for their ventures were shared to motivate participants.

5. Presentation of Ideas:

Students were encouraged to brainstorm and present their startup ideas in small groups. Faculty and volunteers guided them through the basic framework of creating a business idea, refining it, and pitching it effectively. Some innovative ideas were appreciated and suggestions for further development were given.

Outcome of the Event:

The program successfully heightened awareness among students regarding entrepreneurship and startups. Participants left with a clearer understanding of the resources and support systems available to them. Many students expressed their enthusiasm to participate in future workshops and even initiate startup projects. The session helped build confidence and sparked creativity among the students, laying a strong foundation for future entrepreneurs.

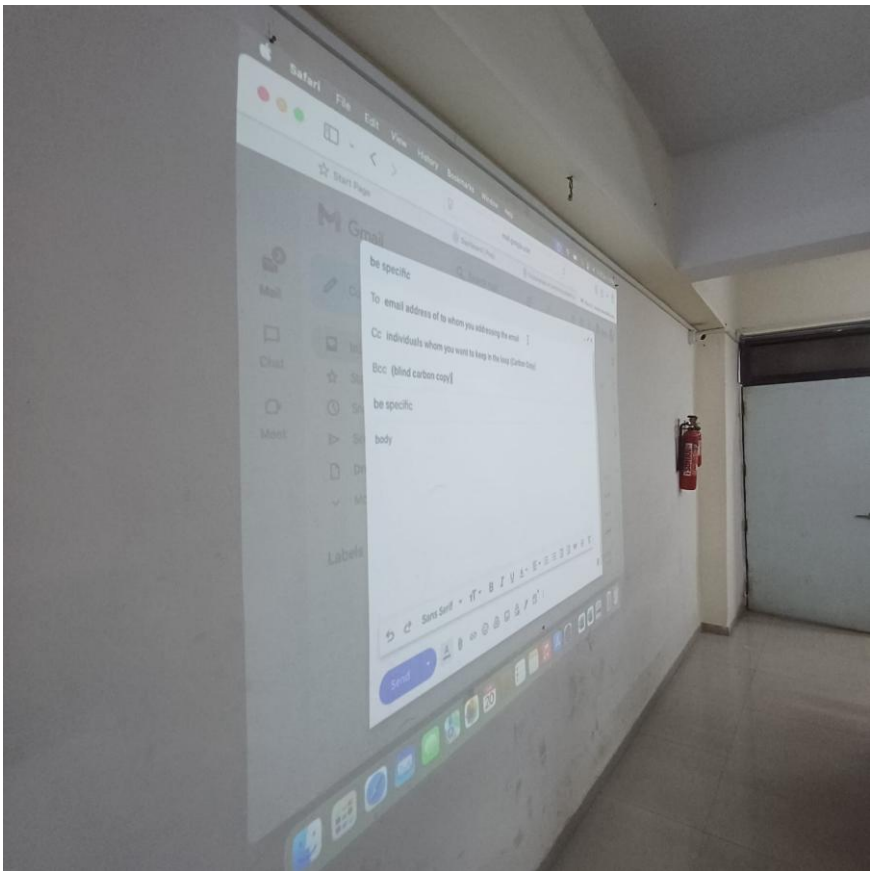

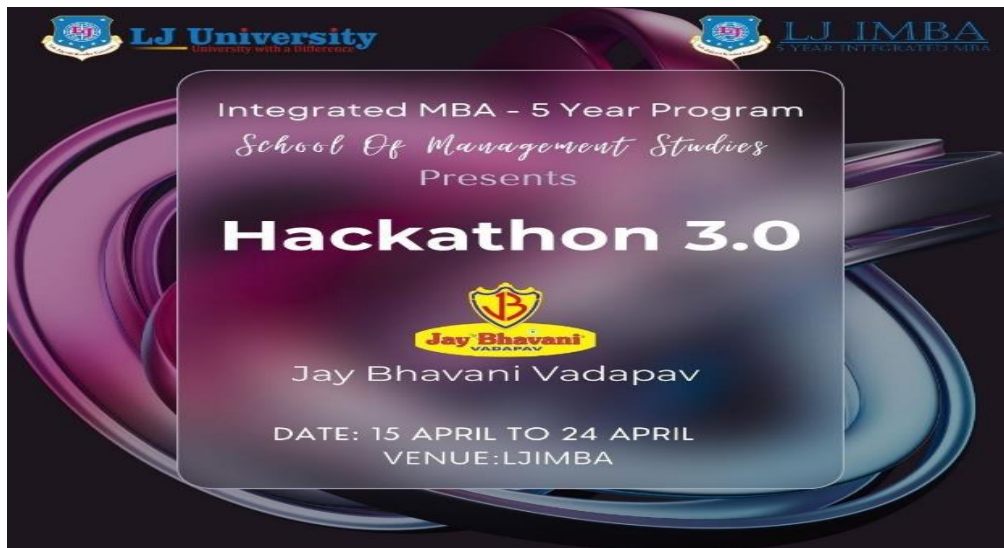
